NWS to name Indianapolis International a StormReady facility Thursday at 12:30 p.m.

INDIANAPOLIS—Representatives from the National Oceanic & Atmospheric Administration (NOAA and Indianapolis Airport Authority (IAA) officials will gather Thursday as Indianapolis International Airport (IND) is recognized for its designation as a StormReady[®] airport.

The airport's operations team recently completed a rigorous process to earn the distinction in partnership with NOAA's National Weather Service (NWS) in Indianapolis.

Other than Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County Airport (DTW), Indianapolis International is only airport in the U.S. with the StormReady[®] designation.
