OUTER-LOT MOWING QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following questions were received before the deadline stated in the bid documents. Answers are stated after each question and this information is not in any specific order.

Q1 Some of the surface lots have grass areas between the curbs and perimeter fences. Are these areas part of the outlot mowing or surface lot maintenance? If they are part of the surface lot maintenance what is the frequency of the mowing required? Also, some of the surface lots already have tall weeds growing in the lots and perimeter fences. Will these require trimming before a spray regimen is started.

A1 The areas in question between the curbs and the fence will need to be mowed on the same schedule and at the same height as the lot mowing. Weeds will be trimmed by in-house forces during the winter.

Q2 What was last years award amount and the last five if possible?

A2 The last year amount was a not-to-exceed of \$110,250.00

Q3 Is there anyway I can get a bigger map?

A3 No this is the only map we have available for this project

Q4 How many parcels/acreages will need to be cut?

A4 Reference the bid documents. The acreage for the Noise Program mowing could change with the amount of lots the IAA is responsible for at any time.

Q5 Is it public record, information concerning who the bid was awarded to last year, how many acres were cut-price?

A5 The previous contractor was Groundhog Inc. See A2 for last year contract amount.

Q6 If cycles are every two weeks can 1/2 of work be performed 1 week and other half second week?

A6 That should be fine as long as each area is mowed every two weeks.

Q7 Is it possible to get one contract and not the other?

A7 Yes
