



Shuttles will run from airport to race track for Red Bull Indianapolis GP on August 29

INDIANAPOLIS—Race fans who want quick, convenient transportation to and from the Indianapolis Motor Speedway for the Red Bull Indianapolis GP on Sunday, August 29 can take comfortable, air-conditioned shuttles from Indianapolis International Airport.

The Free Enterprise System's blue route will run from the airport every 45 minutes starting at 8:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. before the start of the race.

The post-race shuttle service will run for two hours after the conclusion of the final race. The staging area for pick-up and drop-off is in the 1200 block of Main Street at the corner of Main & Gilman.

Tickets can be purchased on-side on race day from 8 to 11 a.m. for \$22 per person.

- Parking at the airport for those taking the shuttle will be on the top (level 5) floor of the parking garage. Cost for parking is \$10 for those who show their race ticket stubs to cashiers upon exit. Without a race ticket stub, drivers will be charged the regular \$18 daily rate for garage parking.
- Once parked, fans can take elevators or stairs to the first floor of the garage and proceed to the Ground Transportation Center (GTC) lobby. Tickets can be purchased at the Star of America booth.
- Shuttles will pick-up and drop-off race fans in Zone 1, just outside the GTC lobby. The pick-up times are 8:30 a.m., 9:15 a.m., 10 a.m., 10:45 a.m., and 11:30 a.m.
- After the race, fans should report to 1200 Main (corner of Main & Gilman streets) for the blue route shuttles back to the airport.
