



I-70 between I-65 and I-465 to be closed Thursday, October 7 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

INDIANAPOLIS—Passengers, visitors, and the general public who will be visiting Indianapolis International Airport between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Thursday, October 7 should be aware that I-70 will be closed for a major beautification project.

Part of the Third Annual Lilly Global Day of Service, the project is billed “A Greener Welcome” and will involve more than 9,000 volunteers, 16 semi loads of trees and 24 semi loads of other plant material, including shrubs and perennial flowers.

To ensure the safety of the volunteers, the I-70 interstate will be closed for this 12-hour time period.

If you have a flight on October 7, or if you will be traveling to Indianapolis International Airport to greet arriving passengers on October 7, please be aware of this project. PLAN AN ALTERNATE ROUTE IN ADVANCE AND ALLOW EXTRA TIME FOR THE DETOUR.
