



CFO Marsha Stone honored in 2011 Women of Influence awards

INDIANAPOLIS – Marsha Stone, CFO of the Indianapolis Airport Authority (IAA), was recognized today during the *Indianapolis Business Journal (IBJ)* 2011 Women of Influence awards. The awards are presented to women of Central Indiana who have shown outstanding leadership in various fields.

In presenting the award, the *IBJ* noted that Stone helped lead “the financing for the new terminal and is shaping local economic development by attempting to increase nonstop flights into Indianapolis. Active in the industry on a national level, she is helping redefine aviation at a critical point in its history.”

Stone was also praised for her work on completing the groundbreaking Airline Use Agreement with airlines serving the Indianapolis International Airport, which “has been hailed nationally as a new approach to working with airlines as business partners.”

Stone oversees all accounting, financial reporting, budgeting, capital financing, human resources, business development, air service development, and other revenue-generating functions for Indianapolis International Airport and five general aviation facilities owned by the IAA.
