Appointed by the Mayor of Indianapolis to the Indianapolis Airport Authority board in January of 2008, **MICHAEL B. STAYTON** was elected President of the IAA Board in April of 2009.

Mr. Stayton founded the United States Infrastructure Corporation (USIC) in 2008 and currently serves as its President & CEO. Prior to forming USIC, he spent five years as chief of staff for the United Nations World Food Programme (WFP), the largest international humanitarian agency in the world, in Rome.



Prior to his tenure at WFP, Stayton held positions including President of IWC Industries; President and CEO of SM&P Utility Resources; and Senior Vice President of Energy USA Commercial Group. Director of Public Works & Enterprise Development for the City of Indianapolis from 1993-95, Stayton engaged in venture capital activities from 1980–1993, serving as General Manager and Chief Financial Officer for BioLogicals, Inc.; President of Stayton & Associates, Inc.; Executive Vice President and Director of T.M. Englehart Corp.; and investment committee member of Cambridge Ventures, LP.

He holds a master's degree in international business from the George Washington University and a bachelor's degree from Wabash College.
